

STUDY NOTES FROM KAREN HOERDEL'S "REVELATION" TEACHING SERIES

Revelation Study Notes Chapter 11:3-19

v. 3 - Shows that the Mighty Angel is Jesus

Witness denotes one who can or does declare what he has seen, heard, or knows

Prophecy = proclaim a divine message, hear, judgment and repentance

Sackcloth = the garb of preachers or repentance, of mourners; rough, coarse cloth

v. 4 - Zechariah 4:1-6, 10-14

Olive trees and lamp stands indicates that these two are anointed ones and light bearers

v. 5 - cp. II Kings 1:9-14 - Elijah

v. 6 - I Kings 17:1; James 5:17-18 - Elijah

Exodus 7:20 - Moses

Matthew 17:3 - The Transfiguration

v. 7 - II Kings 2:11 - Elijah (a type of rapture)

Genesis 4:24; Hebrews 11:5 - Enoch (a type of rapture)

Hebrews 9:27 - once to die

Malachi 4:5-6; Matthew 17:9-13 - One must be Elijah!

v. 8 - The city is Jerusalem (where the Lord was slain)

Sodom = perversion, whoredom (spiritual and physical)

Egypt = the world

v. 10 - The Devil's Christmas

v. 13, 14 - Earthquake causes one tenth of Jerusalem to crumble, killing 7,000 people

v. 15-19 - The Seventh Trumpet - The Third Woe

Beginning the last half of The Tribulation

The Temple of God is opened in Heaven

The Ark = God's ultimate triumph and faithfulness
