Revelation Study Notes Chapter 22

- v. 1 - "Out of the throne" (Cp. Genesis 2:10; Ezekiel 47:1-12) - Water = Holy Spirit
- v. 2 - "Healing" (Greek "therapeia") - care; health
- v. 3 - Genesis 3:14-19, 21-24 - now no curse
- v. 4 - "See His face" - Cp. Matthew 5:8; I John 3:2
Foreheads - Cp. Revelation 3:12; 7:1-8; 14:1; 13:16-17
Foreshadowed in Exodus 28: 36-38
- v. 6 - Links to the opening - Revelation 1:1-8
- v. 7 - Jesus announces His near return in 7, 12, and 20
"Keeps" = keep in mind, but more, to obey
- v. 8-9 - Cp. John 21:24; I John 1:1-3
- v. 10 - Cp. Daniel 12:4, 9
- v. 12 - Faith saves us, but we are rewarded for works
I Corinthians 3:12-15; II Corinthians 5:10-11; Romans 14:10-13
- v. 13 - Cp. Revelation 1:8, 17 - Jesus claims He is God
- v. 14 -15 - "Without" = Lake of Fire; outer darkness
"dogs" = impure, heathen, unredeemed
- v. 16 - Cp. Isaiah 9:7; 11:1
- v. 17 - Cp. Matthew 5:6 - The Bride Says "Come"!
Four invitations for salvation
- v. 18-19 - Deuteronomy 4:2; 12:32; Proverbs 30:6
In the beginning (Revelation 1:3) a blessing is promised to those who read, hear and keep what is written. At the close, a curse is given against those who add or take from it.
- v. 20 - Come, Lord Jesus!

- Endings
- Re-creation (21:1)
- His last rebellion (20:7)
- No more sin (21:4)
- No more curse (22:3)
- No more death (21:4)
- Man restored (21-22)
- Tree of life given back (22:14)
- No sorrow (21:4)
- Marriage of the second Adam (19)
- Man's dominion restored (21-22)
- Satan's dominion ends (20:8-10)
- Satan's doom executed (20:10)
- Man's record, one of eternal peace

Genesis shows us the earthly paradise, with the tree of life and the river of blessing, lost through sin. Revelation gives us the Paradise of God with the tree of life and the pure water of the river of life proceeding out of the throne of God and the Lamb.
